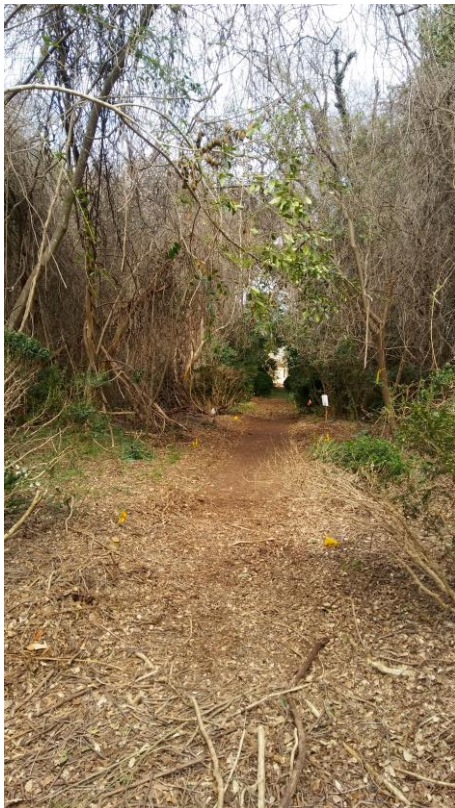
We line up, sign up, and reinenlist early on a bright, sunny February morning.
